Keselowski Looking for Luck at Milwaukee Where K Automotive has Earned Two Poles and One Win in Past Two Years:

After three weeks of bad luck hanging over Brad Keselowski and the K Automotive team, they are looking forward to returning to a race track where they have experienced success for the past two years. Last year the No. 29 Ford sat on the pole and finished seventh while the season prior the team won from the pole position. In the course of the team's nine starts at the Milwaukee Mile they have earned one win, two poles, four top ten finishes and two top five finishes. This season, as the team continues the search for sponsor funding, they are hopeful for a solid showing in the Black Cat Fireworks 200 to end their three week streak of disappointing finishes.

"This is one of the race tracks that I have really been looking forward to coming back to race on this season," said Keselowski. "K Automotive has always run well here, especially the past two years. We sat on the pole both of the last two years and won the race from the pole in 2002. I know this track is not the easiest to get around, but I know we have some great notes on set-ups and I feel like this could very well be the race that turns around the bad luck of recent."

Keselowski has shown patience and perseverance in his rookie season running well each week, but experiencing mechanical problems prior to the finish of the events. Keselowski tested at the Milwaukee Mile earlier this season and feels confident about his abilities, his race team and his equipment heading into the Black Car Fireworks 200 on Friday night.

"I have been pretty proud of the runs we have had at most of these races," said Keselowski. "But unfortunately we have not been able to back up the run with a good finish at the end of the day. We were able to test at Milwaukee earlier this season at the Ford test and had a really good day. I just hope to be able to post a good finish for myself and this entire K Automotive team."

The Black Car Fireworks 200 will take the green flag on Friday, June 25 at 8:00pm CT/9:00pm ET and can be seen Live on Speed Channel as well as heard Live on MRN Radio and XM Radio Channel 144.

Keselowski Family to Be Inducted into Michigan Motorsports Hall of Fame:

Congratulations go out to the Keselowski family, John, Ron, and Bob, for their recent induction in the Michigan Motorsports Hall of Fame.

The late John Keselowski was the team owner for Ron, who was the driver, and Bob, who was the crew chief. Ron started several NASCAR Premier Series races in the 1970s and won a United States Auto Club 500-miler at Pocono.

In the late 1970s, Bob took over driving chores while Ron served as the head mechanic and the combination won dozens of late model races across the Midwest and track championships at Mt. Clemens and Toledo before tackling the ARCA Re/MAX Series. Bob was the 1989 ARCA champion, and in 1995, the team moved to the NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series.

Bob won the 1997 FasMart 200 at Richmond before relinquishing driving duties of the K-Automotive truck to the likes of Dennis Setzer, Terry Cook, Frank Kimmel, and now his youngest son Brad Keselowski. In addition, the team also fields late model cars for eldest son Brian and intends to enter several ARCA races with Brian at the wheel as well.

The induction ceremony will be held at the University Comfort Inn in Mount Pleasant, MI on Sunday afternoon, November 7, 2004. Tickets are available to the general public.
