Renshaw Hoping to Speak the Same Language as the 'Lady in Black': If there is one race track on the NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series circuit that can intimidate even the most experienced veterans, it would be the Darlington Raceway. This weekend, Deborah Renshaw will take her first laps around the 'lady in black' and maybe trade in her rookie stripe for a famed 'Darlington stripe' en route to another top-15 finish. Renshaw is hoping that the 'lady in black' will help her navigate around the tricky 1.366-mile speedway.

"This is one of those race tracks that you always hear about how tough it is to get around, but you also hear about what a fun track it is to run at," said Renshaw. "Lately I have spoken with some of my ARCA friends and they have referred to Darlington as a large version of the Salem Speedway. I actually feel like Darlington will be a track that I have a good chance of a strong run because of the long straightaways and banked corners. When I ran the ARCA car at Salem last season, I earned the third starting position and ran strong throughout the race so that definitely gives me some added confidence for Darlington."

K Automotive Motorsports has competed at the Darlington Raceway in all three of the NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series events that have been held at the track. Of their three starts the team has started in the top ten all three times and finished in the top ten in two of the three races. With only two races remaining in the 2004 season, Renshaw is looking forward to capitalizing on the team's experience and possible better her career-best NCTS finish from Martinsville Speedway of a 15th place finish.

"One thing that has been a huge help this season are the incredible notes that K Automotive has for the race tracks," said Renshaw. "The set-ups are already so close when we get ready for the first practice that I can really focus on running the line of the track and getting comfortable for qualifying and the race. This weekend will be no different especially with the runs that this team has had at Darlington in the past. And I think this is a track where we will be trying to get as much time on the track as possible during practice Thursday afternoon."

The Darlington 200 will take the green flag at 8:00pm ET on Friday, November 12, 2004 at the Darlington Raceway in South Carolina. The race will be televised Live on Speed Channel. Qualifying for the race will be held on Thursday, November 11 at 3:30pm ET.
