Keselowski Prepared for First ARCA Start at Home Track of Michigan International Speedway: Brian Keselowski is preparing to make his first career start at the Michigan International Speedway this weekend in the ARCA Re/Max Series race. Keselowski, a native of Rochester Hills, Michigan, has been to the two-mile speedway in Brooklyn, Michigan several times with his father, Bob, or working with his family's NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series team, but never behind the wheel of a race car. Along with driving duties on his own No. 29 Turn One Steering System Ford in the ARCA Re/Max Series event, Keselowski has also been busy helping at the K Automotive NCTS shop where his younger brother, Brad, is preparing for his first event at MIS as well.

"It has been crazy trying to get ready for this weekend," said Keselowski. "Our team has worked really hard to get both race vehicles ready for the Michigan events and of course there is more pressure with it being the first time either of us has run at the speedway in front of family and friends. I have been trying to get this car transformed from the Daytona car into the Michigan car. We changed bodies and hopefully that will make the difference and allow us to have a solid run on Friday. We have quite the power plant under the hood according to Joe Rhyne and I think if I can get the set up where I need it in practice and stay out of trouble, I will have a good shot at no less than a top ten finish."

Keselowski's father and crew chief, Bob Keselowski, has been no stranger to success in ARCA competition and success at the Michigan International Speedway. The 1989 ARCA Champion also scored a win at the family's home track in June of 1992. Keselowski hopes to use much of his father's knowledge in order to lead him to success at Michigan.

"I am relying a lot on my dad's advice to get around this place," said Keselowski. "He has such a tremendous amount of knowledge about all of these tracks and how to get the ARCA cars tuned in just right. Having him behind me to help guide me in these races makes all the difference because not only do I get a lot of guidance from him, but it is a great way to spend more time with my dad doing something that means a lot to both of us."

The Hantz Group 200 will mark Keselowski's first ARCA Re/Max Series start of the 2005 season. Keselowski competed in six ARCA Re/Max Series events in the 2004 season with his best finish coming at the Toledo Speedway where he finished eighth. The Hantz Group 200 will take the green flag at 5:00pm on Friday, June 17 and will be televised live on SPEED Channel.
