## Brad Keselowski No. 29 Samson Stone Ford F-150 Race Notes

### Feature Stories

**A First Visit to Phoenix for Keselowski:** Brad Keselowski will take to the one mile Phoenix International Raceway for the first time this weekend in the Chevy Silverado 150. Keselowski is excited to take to one of the original race tracks on the NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series circuit for the first time in his NCTS career.

"Phoenix is definitely one of the original race tracks that the trucks ran on," said Keselowski. "For our series this is really where the racing started so to get the chance to race here for the first time is pretty exciting. I know this is a tough race track where track position is everything because passing is so difficult, but I think this track also behaves more like a short track than a speedway."

The K Automotive team is also very familiar with the Phoenix International Raceway as they have competed on the one-mile track on 13 different occasions scoring six top ten finishes including a sixth place finish in the spring of 1997 with Keselowski's father, Bob, behind the wheel of the truck. Five of the team's top ten finishes came in a string of events between 1998 and 2002.

"Our team has performed pretty well here at Phoenix in the past," said Keselowski. "My dad has helped me a lot in preparing for this race as far as how to run this track with it being so flat. He had a great run here back in 1997 finishing sixth and I just hope we can get a solid run this weekend to make up for the problems we experienced at Texas last weekend. These last five races can really be challenging on the teams because there is such a distance between them and it makes it a real challenge to get your trucks ready and get them between race tracks in such short periods of time."

Keselowski enters this weekend's Chevy Silverado 150 in the 22nd position in NCTS Championship points, 87 points behind the 21st position. This weekend's event is the 24th of 25 events making up the 2005 NCTS season. The Chevy Silverado 150 will take the green flag at 8:00pm ET on Friday, November 11, 2005 and can be seen live on Speed Channel.
