Brad Keselowski No. 29 Samson Stone Ford F-150 Race Notes

Keselowski Focuses on Past Team Success and Extensive Preparation for IRP Battle:

Brad Keselowski will be making his first career start at the half-mile battleground of Indianapolis Raceway Park on Friday evening in the PowerStroke Diesel 200 NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series event. While Keselowski is new to the IRP short track from a racers perspective, he is certainly not new to the track when it comes to team success. His family's K Automotive Motorsports team has quite an impressive record including three poles, one win and six consecutive top ten finishes, excluding the 2004 season. With an impressive selection of notes and knowledge to draw from, the 21-year old Keselowski has also made a point of testing his No. 29 Samson Stone Ford, affectionately known as 'Super Droop', this past week at IRP in order to get himself familiar with the fast lines around the tricky little race track.

"This is one of those race tracks where we have some pretty awesome notes from over the years and I think we will have a pretty good chance at a solid run if we can avoid the incidents that are bound to happen during the event," said Keselowski. "We made a point of coming to IRP during our off week in order for me to get some laps around the track and work on some things with the truck following the race at Memphis. Unfortunately we lost a motor during the test session, but we were also able to learn a lot for the race weekend. Anytime that I can get some laps in on a track that I have not raced on before is definitely an asset and I think that will hold true here at IRP."

While Keselowski spent his off weekend testing and preparing for this weekend's event in Indianapolis, he was also focusing on next weekend's event at the Nashville Superspeedway. The K Automotive team took some hours at the wind tunnel with their Nashville truck hoping to find some advantages prior to taking to the concrete speedway next weekend.

"There have not been a lot of off weekend's this season so we really tried to take advantage of the time we had this past week," said Keselowski. "The testing at IRP was crucial and so was the wind tunnel time to allow us to take a closer look at our speedway truck before we get to Nashville next weekend. Sitting 20th in the championship points right now means that every position every weekend is extremely important and we want to make sure that we are as prepared as possible every time we get out on the race track."

Keselowski is currently 20th in NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series championship points entering the event at the Indianapolis Raceway Park. He sits 11 points away from the 19th position. The PowerStroke Diesel 200 will take the green flag at 8:00pm CT on Friday evening, August 5. The race can be seen Live on Speed Channel.
