Keselowski Ready to Roll the Dice at Las Vegas: Not only will this weekend mark the first for Brad Keselowski to race at the Las Vegas Motor Speedway, but it will also mark the first time the 21-year old will be able to have some fun in the casinos that have made Las Vegas. While Keselowski is focused on a solid run on the mile and a half speedway, he knows that racing on yet another track for the first time is always a gamble.

"These past several races have been all about learning these race tracks in a hurry and then racing on them for the first time," said Keselowski. "We have done really well on the shorter tracks, but Las Vegas is a larger speedway and I am just hoping that we are good off the truck. We are running the same truck that we used in Texas earlier this season and I know we were pretty good there, but we struggled with horsepower. I have heard a lot of good things about the Las Vegas track regarding how smooth the track is and how much fun it can be to race."

The K Automotive team will take to the Las Vegas Motor Speedway with a special paint scheme on their No. 29 Samson Stone Ford, representing the parent company of Samson Stone, Petra Stone Inc. The team will showcase the same blue and black paint scheme that they ran previously this season, but will return to the now-familiar Samson Stone orange truck for the next event at Martinsville Speedway. With eight prior starts at Las Vegas by the K Automotive team, Keselowski will have a great amount of knowledge to get him through the one-day event.

"Our team has always enjoyed coming out to Las Vegas for this race," said Keselowski. "I have never really had the chance to enjoy anything other than the race track and have been forced to stand on the outskirts of the casino rather than walk around and try them out. But this is the first time being in Vegas since I have turned 21, so I guess I will have to try my luck."

Keselowski looks to have another solid point's day in Las Vegas in order to break into the elusive top-20 in driver points. He currently sits in the 22nd position, only 20 points away from 21st position and 102 points away from the 20th position. Keselowski and the rest of the NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series competitors will take the green flag on Saturday, September 24 at 9:00pm ET. The race will be televised live on Speed Channel.
