



## Brad Keselowski No. 29 K Automotive Motorsports Ford F-150 Race Notes

#### Keselowski Moves Up to 20th in Series Points Adding Momentum to

**Charlotte Race:** Brad Keselowski and the K Automotive team have been on the move in NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series points for the past three events. Following his 13th place finish at the short track of Mansfield Motorsports Speedway this past week, Keselowski moved into the 20th position giving him that extra boost of momentum as the team makes the transition from short track to speedway to compete at the Lowe's Motor Speedway in Charlotte. The NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series shares the stage with the NASCAR Nextel Cup All-Star weekend at the mile and a half speedway.

"There is really a lot of momentum behind our race team this weekend," said Keselowski. "We had a great run at Mansfield and we have continued to move forward in the series points which is a great accomplishment in its own right. We have some very special guests attending the race with us at Charlotte and that is adding a lot to our team and I think there are going to be some exciting weeks to come for K Automotive that hopefully we will be able to talk more about in the near future. But we are just focused on one race at a time and getting the most out of those events."

Keselowski will be driving the same truck that he competed with at both the California Speedway and at the Atlanta Motor Speedway earlier this season. The truck was new to the K Automotive stable at the California event and as the full moon of the evening shined down, the truck received its name from the team members, 'Moon Doggy'. While the truck as not yet finished to the capability the team knows it possesses, Keselowski expects Charlotte to turn the tide for one of his favorite race trucks.

"I am probably one of the few people on this team that really likes this truck," said Keselowski. "I spent a lot of time over the off season getting this truck ready and California was probably a little too early to try to make its first run, but we learned a lot before the Atlanta race. This is a really good truck and I think we are looking for another consistent run at Charlotte so we can continue this climb in series points and get focused on a very busy month of racing in June when we start racing every weekend."

Keselowski is currently 20th in series points with 620 points, only 35 points away from the 15th position. The Quaker Steak and Lube 200 will take the green flag at 8:45pm and will be televised live on Speed Channel.
