Keselowski Taking a New Friend Along for the Ride at Home Track of Michigan International Speedway: For most race teams, the event at the Lowe's Motor Speedway is considered the team's home track where all the family and friends come to the track. This is certainly not the case for Brad Keselowski and his K Automotive Motorsports team. With their Lake Orion, Michigan race shop only two hours from the gates of the Michigan International Speedway, the team is close to home for the 21-year olds first start at his two-mile, home speedway. To add further excitement to the team around this event, the No. 29 Ford will adorn a brand new look with fresh orange paint and a friend of their new sponsor, Samson Stone, appropriately named 'Sam', along for the ride on the tonneau cover.

"There has always been a lot of attention around the race here in Michigan for us as a team," said Keselowski. "But this year seems like it has been exceptionally crazy leading up to it. I know with it being my first time ever racing on this track there is a lot of preparation for me as a driver to perform well. But we have also been busy getting the truck painted and ready to look its best this weekend. It is definitely more hectic racing at home, but it is also exciting because this will be the first time for a few of my family members to see me race a truck in person."

The K Automotive team has a healthy track record at Michigan scoring four top ten finishes in five starts. With a fresh race truck and a powerful motor, Keselowski would love nothing more than to find success in front of his friends and family as well as become the first father-son combination to both win in the NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series, especially on Father's Day weekend. Keselowski's father and now crew chief, Bob Keselowski, earned his one and only NCTS win at the Richmond International Raceway in 1997. However Bob Keselowski has visited victory lane at the Michigan International Speedway in an ARCA car in June of 1992.

"I feel like this is one of the most powerful truck and motor combinations that we have had this season," said Keselowski. "With the competitive field of trucks that we will have at Michigan, I would be pretty excited to continue the trend of top ten finishes, but of course winning is always the ultimate goal and becoming the first father and son to each win in the NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series is the first major goal I want to accomplish in my NCTS career."

The Keselowski family will be busy for much of the race weekend at Michigan International Speedway with older son, Brian, competing in Friday's ARCA Re/Max Series event prior to Saturday's running of the NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series event. Brad Keselowski moved up to the 19th position in NCTS points following last weekend's Texas event and now sits only five points away from the 18th position and 59 points away from the 15th position.

The Paramount Health Care Insurance 200 will take the green flag at 3:00pm ET and will be televised live on SPEED Channel as well as broadcast live on MRN Radio and XM Channel 144.
