Keselowski Anxious for First Start at New Hampshire: Brad Keselowski will get his first chance to compete on the one-mile New Hampshire International Speedway this Saturday in the Sylvania 200 presented by Lowe's. Keselowski will be making his 27th career start in the NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series at a race track where victory lane is very familiar to his K Automotive Motorsports team. K Automotive has visited victory lane at New Hampshire twice in the past, in 1999 with Dennis Setzer behind the wheel and in 2002 with Terry Cook behind the wheel. At only 21 years of age, Keselowski would like to add another win to the K Automotive list this weekend.

"It is pretty neat to go to these race tracks where the team has had a lot of success in the past," said Keselowski. "Our program on the shorter tracks like Loudon has really been getting better as I have had more seat time in the truck each week. I think we are coming to the track with awesome set-ups and I am learning how to adapt to these tracks that are new to me quickly during the practice sessions. I know this is a really challenging race track with the flat corners, but I also think it will be a lot of fun to get out there and race."

Keselowski has been improving each week with impressive performances at both Bristol and Richmond which can prove challenging for even veteran drivers. Scoring an 18th place finish and a 16th place finish respectively at those two race tracks has brought Keselowski back to a tie for the 21st position in championship points. While having impressive runs at the past two NCTS events, Keselowski has also managed to keep his truck, 'Super Droop', in one piece and will once again race it this weekend.

"I know we have been really fortunate to keep the fenders on 'Super Droop' at Bristol and Richmond," said Keselowski. "This truck seems to respond well to the set-ups and the adjustments that we make during the race so I think it is the right truck to use again at New Hampshire."

In the nine starts of which K Automotive has made at the New Hampshire International Speedway, they have earned two wins and six top ten starting positions. Keselowski currently sits 22nd in NCTS points as he is tied with Brandon Whitt for the 21st position. The green flag will fly on the Sylvania 200 presented by Lowe's at 3:00pm ET on Saturday, September 17 and can be seen live on Speed Channel.

Brian Keselowski Set for ARCA Event at Salem: While the K Automotive NCTS team competes Saturday in New Hampshire, older brother Brian Keselowski will be making his seventh ARCA Re/Max Series start of the 2005 season on the short track of Salem Speedway in Indiana. The 23-year old Keselowski has already scored five top ten finishes this season in only six starts. Clayton Kesslering will fill in on the NCTS team as jackman this weekend in New Hampshire.
