Keselowski Quotes on Martinsville Practice Session

Brad Keselowski started his practice session at Martinsville speaking about a tight condition in his No. 29 SUBcrews.com Ford. But as the session progressed his truck, 'Super Droop', would get faster and faster. But with a field of 44 trucks that practiced this morning, Keselowski found himself 29th on the speed charts with only five tenths of a second separating him from the fastest truck on the race track.

How was the truck during this morning's practice session?

The truck was really tight early in the run, but as we made more changes we seemed to pick up a lot of time on the track. We made some changes to the shocks and that really improved the handling. But we seemed to get better as the laps continue rather than being fast right away. There for awhile we were losing ground in the straight-aways, but after about five laps or so we seem to really pick up and become one of the fastest trucks on the race track. We need to make it through the traffic without becoming a caution so we can use the strength within 'Super Droop'.

What are your anticipations for qualifying later this afternoon?

Based on practice I think we will have a strong race truck, but I'm not real sure how qualifying is going to go because we didn't get a clean mock qualifying run. When we tried to make our laps we had another truck pull out right in front of us and then we got pushed up onto the curb in turns one and two. Of course that scrubbed a lot of speed off for the laps. But with the field being this close there is really no telling what will happen when the trucks take their qualifying laps.
